OIKONET has started its activities on October 1st 2013. The goal of the three year project co-funded by the Lifelong Learning Programme of the European Union is to create a space of collaboration to study contemporary housing from a multidisciplinary and global perspective. OIKONET will intertwine three areas of activity each one making a subnetwork within the network:

1. RESEARCH on housing studies from a multidisciplinary and global approach;
2. PARTICIPATORY ACTIONS to engage communities in the definition, solution and evaluation of housing problems.
3. PEDAGOGICAL ACTIVITIES will be the result of the collaboration of researchers, universities and communities.

The OIKONET consortium is made of 30 partners from 26 European countries and 4 partners outside Europe. Participating institutions are universities, research institutes, research groups, social organizations, local administrations and international agencies.

The OIKODOMOS digital platform

OIKONET: Expanding the OIKODOMOS Virtual Campus experience

OIKONET will build on the experience gained in the OIKODOMOS Virtual Campus, a project developed between 2007 and 2011 also with the support of the Lifelong Learning Programme. The already consolidated virtual campus will grow into a network by: 1. incorporating other disciplines to the study of contemporary housing, such as economics, sociology, and energy efficiency; 2. enhancing the partners' profiles to include social and professional organizations; 3. addressing the global dimension of housing research, by including third countries in the consortium; 4. and expanding the existing OIKODOMOS digital platform with new environments to support the network activities.

Participation

CIVIC HOUSING

During the Winter semester 2013-14, a "Research Seminar on Contemporary Housing" is taking place at the School of Architecture La Salle about the theme "Civic Housing". The purpose of the seminar is to develop strategies to foster the participation of dwellers in the design, use and transformation of housing. OIKONET partners participate in the activities of the seminar with videoconferences and by sharing the learning activities carried out in OIKODOMOS Workspaces.

RECENT ACTIVITIES

Two OIKONET partners -Sostre Civic, a non-profit association dedicated to promote cooperative housing, and the School of Architecture La Salle are collaborating in a pedagogic project aimed at involving dwellers in the transformation of an existing building in the Born neighborhood in Barcelona.

The first meeting of the subnetwork RESEARCH will take place December 19th 2013 School of Built and Natural Environment, University of Central Lancashire (UCLan), in Preston, UK. The meeting is led by Prof. Karim Hadjri, leader of the work package RESEARCH.

The subnetwork PEDAGOGY will have its first meeting January 10th, 2014 at the School of Architecture La Salle, Barcelona. The meeting is organized by Prof. Leandro Madrazo, coordinator of the OIKONET project.
